Pasar Ide dan Inovasi

Pasar Ide dan Inovasi bertujuan mendorong peserta untuk menemukan berbagai peluang kolaborasi antar para praktisi pembangunan. Peserta Pasar Ide dan Inovasi terdiri dari praktisi pembangunan yang menyajikan presentasi digital pada LED *display*, yang akan diputar selama IDF2017 berlangsung pada tanggal 9-10 Agustus 2017.

Pada tanggal 10 Agustus 2017 pk. 12.30-15.00 akan ada sesi khusus bagi inovator pembangunan yang menjadi pembicara pada 6 buah Mini-Stage untuk Sesi Pasar Ide dan Inovasi. Dalam sesi ini, pembicara akan melakukan *pitching* ide dan inovasi sosial secara ringkas dan cepat untuk percepatan penurunan kesenjangan ekonomi dan sosial di Indonesia. Setelah *pitching*, pembicara diberikan kesempatan berinteraksi dengan audiens, melakukan transaksi sosial, dan mengeksplorasi kerjasama strategis dan kolaborasi programatik.

Ideas and Innovations Marketplace

The Ideas and Innovations Marketplace is a designated interactive space for participants to discover and explore opportunities for collaborating with each other as development practitioners. Ideas and Innovations Marketplace participants are development practitioners who will showcase their innovations and ideas in the form of digital materials on LED displays, running throughout IDF2017 on 9-10 August 2017.

A special session for development innovators will be held on 10 August 2017, from 12.30-15.00 on 6 Mini-Stages in the Ideas and Innovation Marketplace. In this session, speakers will pitch their social ideas and innovations for the acceleration of economic and social inequality in Indonesia. Each pitch will be short and succinct. After each pitch, the speaker will be given have the opportunity to interact with the audience, conduct social transactions, and explore strategic and programmatic cooperation opportunities.

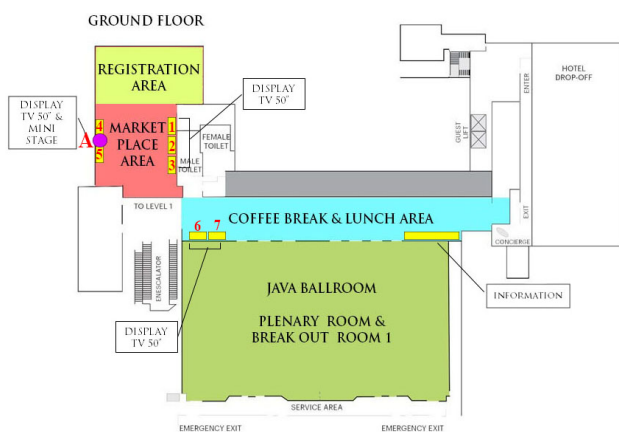
