- Entrepreneurship as a cornerstone of economies policies









- Regional variation of start-up is present
- Start-up in Java and Bali are generally lower partly due to
 - Sob opportunities
 - Minimum wage
 - Fiscal Transfer
- Regional variations in the informal start-up rates are higher

THE EFFECT OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ON START UP



MOST OF START-UP ARE UNREGISTERED INFORMAL BUSINESS

REDUCE COST AND SHORTEN PLANNING PERIOD

LACK OF BENEFIT AND WEAK OF CONTROL BY GOVERNMENT (LAW ENFORCEMENT)

UNEMPLOYMENT TRIGGER ENTREPRENEURSHIP --- SUPPLY

SIZE OF MARKET DEMAND (POPULATION DENSITY) INFLUENCE ENTREPRENEURSHIP ---- DEMAND
