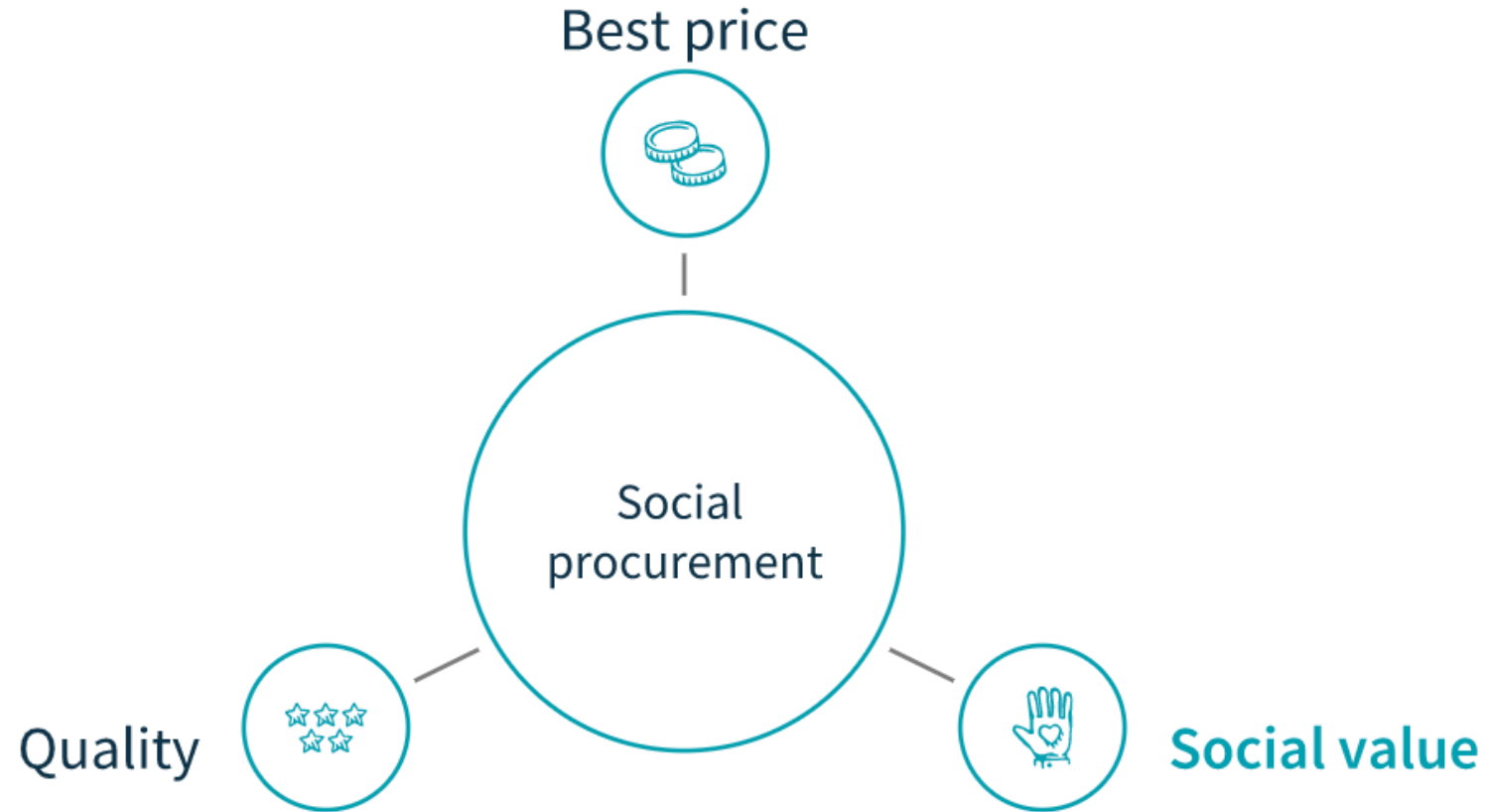
Meanwhile, the government spend a vast amount of money each year...
