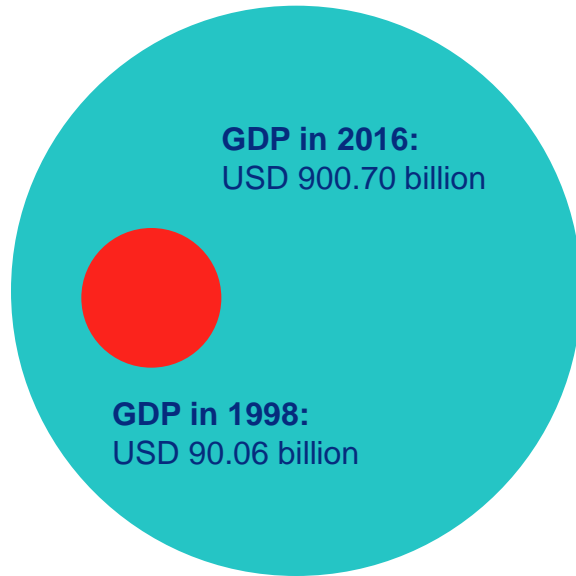

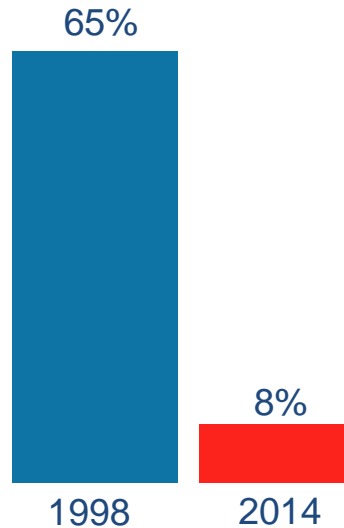

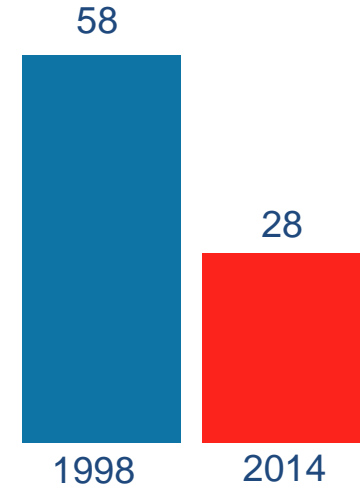
RAPID ECONOMIC GROWTH & SIGNIFICANT DEVELOPMENT GAINS

at \$1.90 per day)**

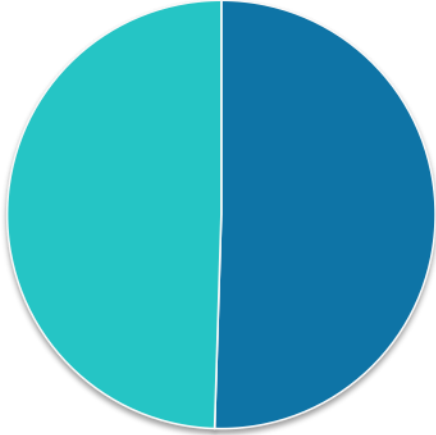


**Under 5 mortality rate
per 1000 live births**

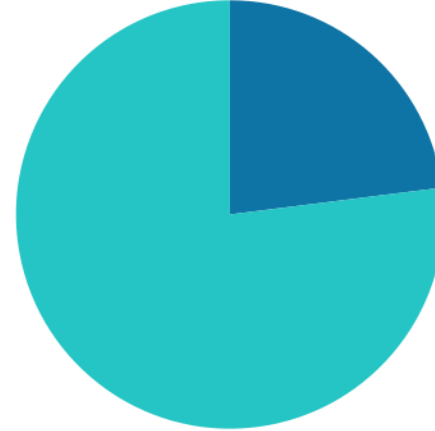

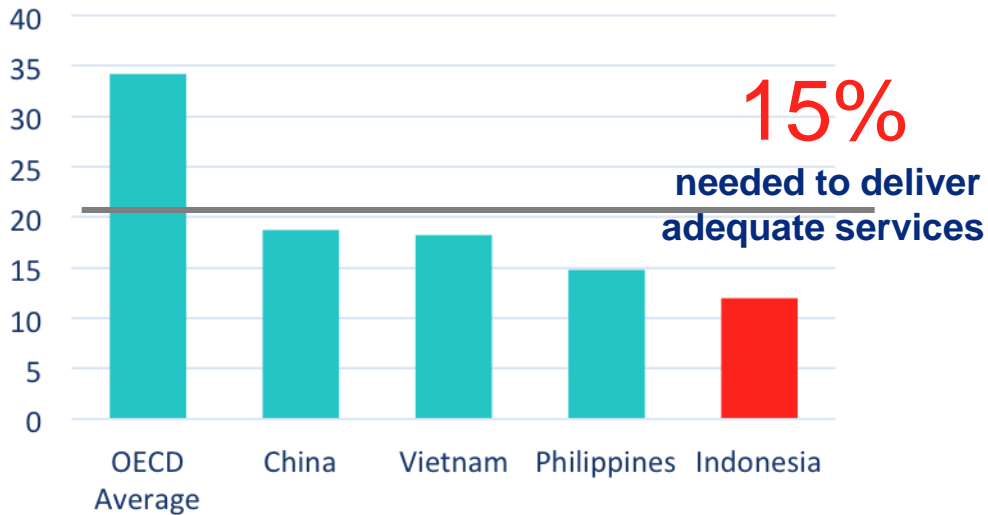
