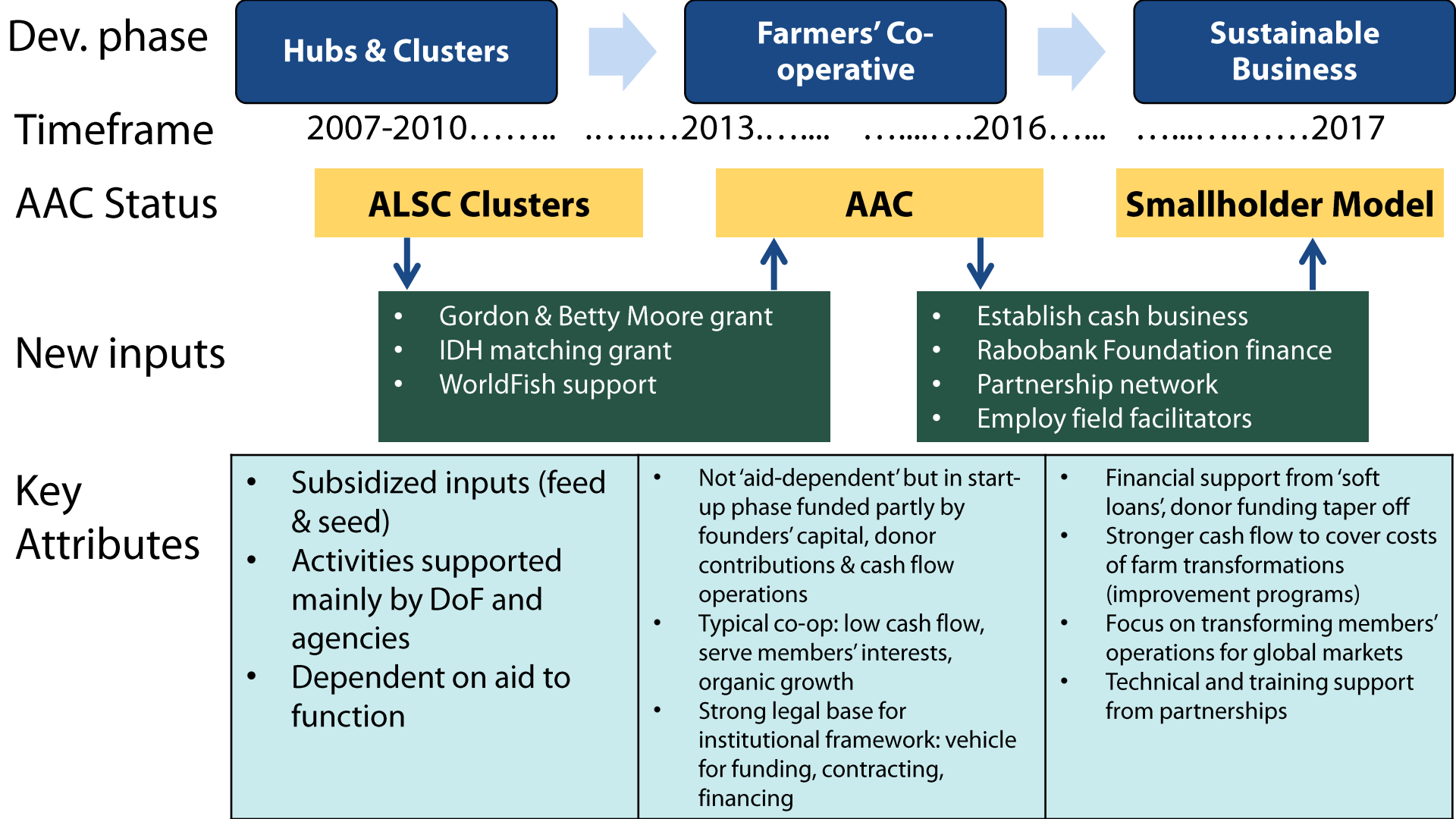

The Story of the Aceh Aquaculture Cooperative (AAC)

- To be a sustainable and environmentally-friendly aquaculture business, market-oriented in accordance with cooperative and equitable economy principles.
- Legally established in 2013
- Initially 32 members; now over 600 members
- 2017 loan of ~IDR 2 billion





Pillars to transform from start-up to sustainable business



1. Initial grant funding
2. Technical and organization-structural support
3. Soft loan
