### Local Economic Governance in 32 Capital Provinces in Indonesia


#### **Inequality of permit ownership**

The Level of permit ownership (certificate of company registration and trading business license) of smaller scale businesses is lower than the large businesses.



#### **Inequality of accessing Business Development Program (BDPs)**

The Level of participation of the small scale businesses is significantly low in several BDP programs. BDPs is provided by local governments.

Padang & Kupang: Giving development training for SMEs
Pontianak: providing policy (fiscal & non-fiscal) incentive for SMEs

## Business Development Program




Access to information (asymmetric-information) through digital platform, social media, citizen forum
